- A language other than English at the 3000 level

Not more than two of the following:

- Physical Education 30
- Religious Studies 30
- CTS (at least three credits or average of three one credit advanced modules)

Averages currently calculated using final diploma results. Possess leadership qualities, demonstrates the qualities of a good citizen and participates in athletics (school/community). Preference will be given to a student not receiving any other monetary award from the school (provided the other award(s) is of higher monetary value). The recipient must be attending a post secondary program. If there is not a male honor student, the award will be presented to a female student who best meets the other criteria. In the event that no student meets all of the above criteria, the student who best meets the above criteria will be awarded the scholarship.
